A Research Associate position is available in the Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health to support the Principal Investigator. The grade of appointment will be accorded based on candidate's academic qualifications and years of relevant experience.

Major duties and responsibility of the post includes:

1. Develop and maintain bioinformatics pipeline(s) related to next-generation sequencing of Gram-negative bacteria
2. Perform sequence and data analysis related to next-generation sequencing of Gram-negative bacteria
3. Reporting key results of data analysis
4. Any other task as assigned by the Supervisor/ PI

In addition, candidate is required to do report writing, presentations and publication of results and findings in peer-reviewed journals. Furthermore, he/she will need to contribute to development and writing of research grant proposals.

Applicants are expected to possess at least a master degree in science, bioinformatics or computational biology. He/she has to be familiar with file management and data analysis in the Unix/Linux environment.
