OCCUPATIONAL TOXICOLOGY AND INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE

WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

Exposure to potentially hazardous substances is common, especially in the workplace setting. Hazard control measures exist but are only effective at protecting health if appropriately chosen and implemented.

This course covers basic principles and key topics in toxicology and industrial hygiene that are relevant to current occupational and public health practice. Participants will have the opportunity to practise problem-solving skills using case studies.
