

Numerous studies have shown that health factors among employees can increase the risk of workplace injuries. Under the MOM Code of Practice of Risk Management revised in 2015, risk assessment conducted by employers should consider organisational culture and personal risk factors that could compromise employees' work ability and safety. Risk management is also an important tool in our Total Workplace Safety and Health efforts, which stress the importance of managing safety and health in a holistic and integrated manner.

WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

This is a hands on course which aims to equip safety and health officers with the knowledge and skills to incorporate personal health factors in their risk assessments. We will also focus on medical conditions which can result in sudden incapacity, other disabilities, or side effects from their treatment during the practical exercises.

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Describe which personal health factors and medical conditions can pose a risk to employees in their workplaces
- Describe for which tasks and workplaces personal factors and conditions might be safety-critical
- Develop options for their company to include personal health factors in their risk assessment and risk control strategies

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Safety and health officers from all industries and auditors who review the risk assessment of workplaces

HOW IS THE COURSE CONDUCTED?

This is a full-day course, which comprises of lectures and practical exercises with close supervision, for participants to plan for a risk assessment of their own workplace, incorporating personal health factors inside.

Participants will be awarded a **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION** at the end of the course, upon completion of the assessment.
