#### 1. Can I read courses from SPH?

SPH courses are opened to students from NUS except those from restricted programmes. Students are expected to fulfil the course pre-requisite(s), if any. The courses read may be used to fulfil unrestricted electives requirements.

## 2. Can I apply Satisfactory/ Unsatisfactory (S/U) options on SPH courses?

## 3. Can I take a Second Major and a Minor of the same subject?

No, you are not allowed to do so.

### 4. How can I declare a Minor in Public Health?

The Minor in Public Health is an 'Open' minor. Students can declare their intention to do so via the Academic Plan Declaration <a href="http://www.nus.edu.sg/ModReg/academic-plan-application-declaration.html">http://www.nus.edu.sg/ModReg/academic-plan-application-declaration.html</a> without any prior approval or by applying through their home Faculties/Schools, no later than the end of the fifth semester of study.

## 5. How does double counting of courses work?

Double counting is to read one or more courses to satisfy the requirements of 2 different programmes simultaneously. Up to 8 units of the Minor may be double counted with the Primary Major/ Second Major requirements.

## 6. Where will the Minor in Public Health be reflected?

The Minor will be reflected in the student's transcript upon successful completion.



# 7. How can I be admitted to a Minor in Public Health at the point of admission?

Students can be admitted to a Minor in Public Health at the point of admission to NUS, or by applying/declaring to the relevant Faculties/Schools no later than the end of the fifth semester of study. ## 8. How do I drop the Minor in Public Health?

The courses that you have obtained may be used to satisfy the Unrestricted Electives requirements.
